He served at the Louis Armstrong International Airport, as Chief, Law Enforcement Detachment and was also Deputy, Orleans Parish Criminal Sheriff's Office. He is P.O.S.T. Certified (Peace Officer Standards & Training) and a Tulane University City College, Instructor.



Sheriff Normand holds the Juris Doctor degree from Tulane Law School and a Bachelor of Science Degree, (Business Administration) from the University of New Orleans. He is a graduate of the FBI National Academy, Quantico, Virginia and of the University of Virginia/Criminal Justice Education program. Newell maintains his continuing education through the Louisiana State University/Criminal Justice-Continuing Education program. He is a graduate of Jesuit High School, New Orleans

Unfortunately, our neighbors to the west, District 6200, suffered significant damage from both storms. Gustav brought the wind and Ike brought the flood. It is estimated

that 20,000 homes were flooded in Houma and the communities to the south of Houma. In the aftermath of Katrina, District 6200 was at our side in our relief and recovery efforts. 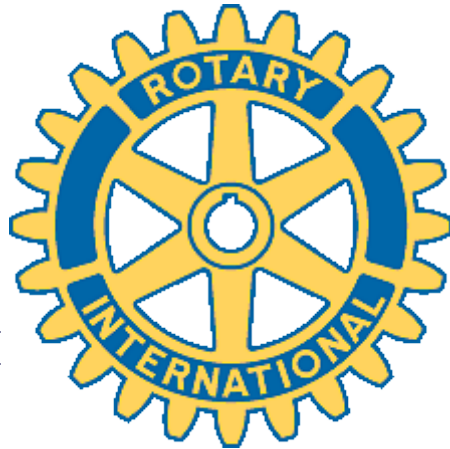
