## Today: Dr. Ed Renwick

### Loyola University Professor and Political Observer

Dr. Renwick was awarded a Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Arizona in 1967 and has been at Loyola University New Orleans since 1970 where he teaches Political Science to undergraduates. Since that time, he has also been the Director of the Institute of Politics, training professionals in the practical applications of the profession of politics.



Over 1,000 fellows have passed through the IOP under Dr. Renwick's tutelage, many of whom are leaders in the political arena both locally and nationally. In addition, Dr. Renwick has been a consultant and pollster since the early 1970s, having executed hundreds of surveys since that time, and was voted Best Pollster of New Orleans by Gambit Newspaper.

He was elected to the Louisiana Political Hall of Fame in 1999. These surveys have been wide ranging - from issue polls, surveys done for political candidates, mall intercept studies, surveys for court cases and for the media.

Renwick retired this June 1, after 38 years of helping to prepare more than 1,100 IOP "fellows" for careers in elective office, political campaigns, and the news media.
