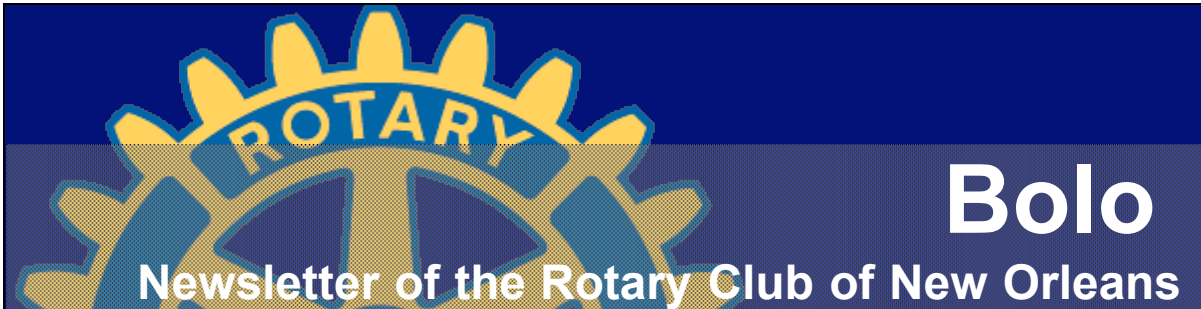

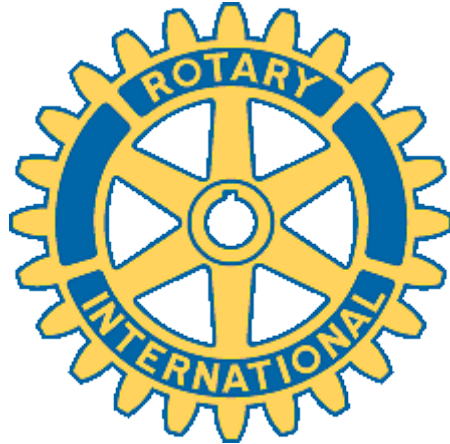
Please bring compact fluorescent bulbs to the Holiday Brunch and/or to any of the Club meetings until the week of December 21. A collection box will be available.
