Elena Lacour was born in Zachary, Louisiana, in 1968. She attended Louisiana State University at Baton Rouge, majoring in Psychology.

Elena has overseen member services for the Louisiana Press Association and the Business & Industry Communications Alliance in Baton Rouge. After four years as regional marketing manager for the Louisiana Association of Business & Industry, she was recruited as Regional Director to reopen the Greater New Orleans office of the Alzheimer's Association Louisiana Chapter. Once shuttered by Hurricane Katrina, the office today provides services, support, education and awareness in eight southeast Louisiana parishes.

Elena was a caregiver to her mother who was diagnosed with frontotemporal dementia at the age of 56. She co-facilitates a twice-monthly support group for persons with early onset Alzheimer's Disease and sits on Mayor Nagin's Advisory Council for Citizens with Disabilities. Elena is certified by the National Alzheimer's Association as a Foundations of Dementia Care master trainer.

Elena and her husband have three children and live in Metairie, Louisiana.

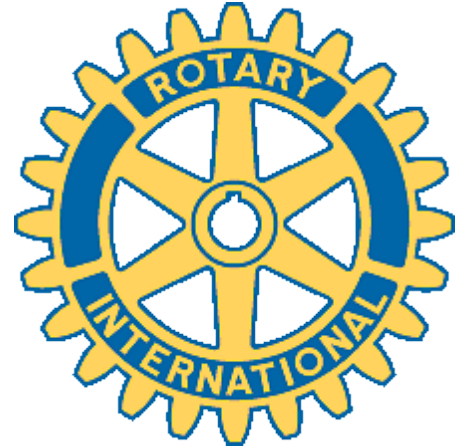
